



Tuition and Fees (Full-Time), AY 2020-21

Thirteen TCUs indicated increases in enrollment. The average increase was 28%. The greatest increases were experienced by TOCC (96%), LBHC (81%), and SGU (74%). Reasons cited include:

Free tuition Hotspot provision

Partial tuition waivers Debt forgiveness

Laptop provision Hybrid classes

Increased dual credit high school enrollments

Online classes allowing working students to attend

Aggressive Recruitment High unemployment

Financial assistance with Internet Meal gift cards

Working with Tribal directors to offer professional

development courses

Reduced mobility and students attending closer to

home

Offering HyFlex learning

Twenty-one TCUs reported decreases in enrollment. The average decrease was 19%. The greatest decreases were experienced by CDKC (100%), RLNC (34%), CMN (27%) and NTU (27%). Reasons cited TCU-wide include:

Cancellation of classes Employment uncertainty

Students struggling to respond to the pandemic Switch to online classes

Lack of resources at home Homeschooling children


Fear of leaving home Having at-risk family members


children



Enrollment by Ethnicity and Status




Enrollment by Status
